Women who smoke have more difficulty becoming pregnant and have a higher risk of never becoming pregnant. 2,4 Smoking during pregnancy can cause tissue damage in the unborn baby, particularly in the lung and brain, and some studies suggests a link between maternal smoking and cleft lip. 1,2 Studies also suggest a relationship between tobacco and miscarriage.

There is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke (SHS). Any exposure is harmful. The only way to fully protect nonsmokers from exposure to SHS indoors is to prohibit all smoking in that indoor space or building.
